20 Defendants COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES and RICHARD GOLDSTON's
21 Motion to Declare the Plaintiff to be a Vexatious Litigant, for
22 Prefiling Review Orders, and for an Order Requiring Plaintiff to
23 Post Security in this Action, came on for hearing January 24, 2006
24 at 8:30 a.m. in Department 34 of the above-entitled Court, the
25 Honorable Paul Gutman, Judge presiding.

26 Amber A. Logan appeared for the defendants and moving
27 parties. Plaintiff, Anant Kumar Tripathi, in pro per, appeared
telephonically.

1 Upon reviewing the moving, opposing, and reply papers and
2 after considering the arguments of the parties, the court held:

3 1. Plaintiff Anant Kumar Tripathi is a vexatious litigant as
4 defined by Code of Civil Procedure § 391 (b) (1), for commencing,
5 prosecuting, or maintaining, in propria persona the following
6 litigations determined adversely to him within the past seven (7)
7 years: Tripathi v. Badgett, U.S. District Court Case No. CV-97-
8 00363; Tripathi v Currier, U.S. District Court Case No. CV-00-
9 02051; Tripathi v. Thompsom, U.S. District Court Case No. CV-03-
10 01122; Tripathi v Shiro, U.S. District Court Case No. CV-04-01086;
11 Tripathi v Shiro, U.S. District Court Case No. CV-04-022228;
12 Tripathi v Felix, U.S. District Court Case No. CV-05-0762; Tripathi
13 v. County of Los Angeles, California Superior Court Case No.
14 BC326528; Tripathi v. City of Beverly Hills, California Superior
15 Court Case No. BC330433; Tripathi v. Faron, California Superior
16 Court Case No. BC331166; Tripathi v. Superior Court, California
17 Court of Appeals No. B186762; and Tripathi v. Superior Court,
18 California Supreme Court No. S138599.

19 2. Plaintiff, Anant Kumar Tripathi is a vexatious litigant
20 as defined by Code of Civil Procedure § 391 (b) (2), having
21 relitigated or attempted to relitigate the same cause of action,
22 claim, controversy, and issues of fact or law, previously
23 determined against him in Tripathi v. County of Los Angeles,
24 Richard Golston, U.S. District Court Case No. CV-96-2303, by
25 filing: Tripathi v. County of Los Angeles, California Superior
26 Court Case No. BC326528, Tripathi v. City of Beverly Hills,
27 California Superior Court Case No. BC330433, and Tripathi v. County

1 of Los Angeles and Richard Golston, California Superior Court Case
2 No. BC343351.

3 3. Pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure § 391.1, the
4 defendants have shown that there is not a reasonable probability
5 that the plaintiff will prevail against them in this litigation.

6 **THUS, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED ADJUDGED AND DECREED that:**

7 1. The Defendants' motion to declare Anant Kumar Tripathi a
8 vexatious litigant is GRANTED.

9 2. The Defendants' motion for prefiling review of all new
10 litigation filed by the plaintiff in the State of California is
11 GRANTED.

12 3. The court shall execute and the clerk of the court shall
13 serve the Judicial Council's Prefiling Order form, filed
14 concurrently herewith, upon the California Judicial Council.

15 4. The Defendants' motion to require plaintiff to furnish
16 security in this action is GRANTED.

17 5. The plaintiff is ordered to post security in the amount
18 of fifty-thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) and to file and serve
19 notice within sixty (60) days.

20 6. All other matters in this case are ordered STAYED until
21 the plaintiff furnishes security. All previously noticed hearings
22 are taken off-calendar.


